Construction in Moville

There will be many areas of Moville that will be impacted this spring and summer through street improvements and additions. Construction for the housing addition at Meredith Lane will pick up where it left off last spring by putting in water and sewer lines where homes will be erected.

The West part of Main Street and the sidewalk in front of City Hall will also be seeing a facelift, construction that was pushed back from last fall will be completed this spring. While the date hasn't been confirmed we are anticipating work in front of City Hall will begin once RP Constructors are able to finish work at Meredith Lane.

The sidewalk along Fair street also has an anticipated construction date of summer 2019.

We are excited to add and improve streets and sidewalks in the City of Moville to help provide safe transportation routes for residents that are both walking, rolling and driving.

MOVILLE FARMER'S MARKET

The Menville Farmer's Market will be open again this season! Last year there were over twenty vendors, musicians and presenters throughout the season that helped make the first year a success.

The 2019 season will start on May 30th kicking off Menville Days and will run through September 26th. It will be open Thursday from 4:30-7pm with the exception of holidays and the week of the Woodbury Co. Fair. Some of the items you will be able to see at the Market this year will be: fresh produce, plants, crocheted items, baked goods, scrubbies, soy candles, body scrubs, and much more!

The Education Station was such a hit last year it will be back again this season! The focus will stay the same; providing educational opportunities for kids to learn about wildlife and local plant life. Along with the Education Station the Iowa State University Extension and Outreach program will also be at the Market this year with a new program also geared toward kids-the PoP Club. PoP stands for the "Power of Produce". The focus will be to work with kids on making healthy food choices through engaging activities and taste testing local produce. This will also be a FREE program for kids that sign up. Keep an eye out for more information to come!



BUILDING PERMITS

Menville City Council has a Building Inspector to handle most permits. Permits are available on the city's website, visitmenville.com under the City Hall tab or you can stop at City Hall and pick up a permit. Once the permit has been completed the form can be submitted to City Hall and the City Building Inspector will be notified. Please remember this process does take around ten days. If you are planning a construction project, be sure to calculate the time it takes the Inspector to do his job.

Permits are required for: **BUILDING, REPURPOSING, REMODELING, FENCE, SIDEWALK, and OPEN GRADING PERMITS.** Please call City Hall with any questions you may have with regard to building permits.



SPRING REMINDERS...

Open Burning. This is available for yard waste only and is scheduled for April 20th through May 5th. ONLY during this designated time period are you allowed to burn yard waste. The City provides a yard waste dump site (for Menville residents) located southwest of the CPS facility; you may dispose of yard waste, branches and leaves at this location. Please take care to place the materials in the correct piles and do not leave plastic bags or garbage at the site. The tree dump is not for building materials/boards, etc.



•**Mowing** Do not mow grass clippings into the streets. The grass clippings clog the storm sewers and can cause sewer backups. It is expensive for both the city and home owner.

•**Weed/Mowing Complaints** Grass and/or weeds need to be mowed by the 15th of the month from May through October. If grass and/or weeds are not mowed by that time the city crew will mow the yard. The fee for mowing and cutting weeds shall be fifty dollars (\$50) per hour plus administrative fees, those fees will be assessed to the homeowner. See the newspaper for monthly notice.

•**Operating Golf Carts** Golf carts are allowed on city streets by persons possessing a valid driver's license. However, a golf cart shall not be operated upon Hwy 140. The golf carts need to have a slow moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag and operate on the streets only from sunrise to sunset.

•**Operating ATV/UTV's** Same rules apply as operating a golf cart.

*City water lines will be flushed April 16th and 17th.
North of Main Street will be the 16th and South of Main Street will be the 17th.

CATALANO'S WILL BE BACK IN MOVILLE!

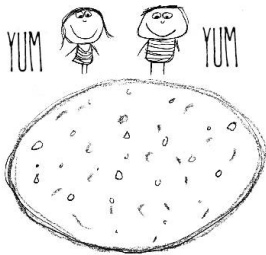
We are excited to announce that our friends from Catalano's will be back in Moville this summer with their amazing wood fire pizzas!

STATEWIDE SAFETY PROGRAM

Moville Police Department will be participating in Iowa's sTEP (special Traffic Enforcement Program). This is a statewide program for law enforcement in Iowa to cooperative "high visibility" traffic enforcement.

These events call for heightened traffic enforcement for all traffic violations with the main effort to raise awareness in safety belt use as the best means of protection in the case of a motor vehicle collision.

May 20th through June 2nd will be the next sTEP dates for the City of Moville.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

Spring is here and summer is just around the corner. It's time to start getting seeds and plants ready for the garden. Moville's Community Garden is tilled and when weather permits ready for planting!

Plot sizes are 10ft x 20ft \$18; 15ft x 20ft \$26; 20ft x 20ft \$30. There are some basic rules stating you will be a good steward of your plot that you are asked to follow. At the end of the season half of your plot fees will be returned to you after you clean up for the season.
