

## Permits, Pets, Curfew

### Building & Fence Permits

- ◆ Required for any new structure, addition or fences
- ◆ Must be submitted to City Council for review and approval.
- ◆ Permits are available at City Hall or online at [www.visitmenville.com](http://www.visitmenville.com)

### Sidewalk Permits

- ◆ Required to replace existing sidewalk or install new sidewalk.
- ◆ Site will be reviewed by the public works director to assure the project will meet minimum code requirements.

### Pets

- ◆ All pets shall be registered yearly in May.
- ◆ Dogs and cats are required to be on a leash or under control at all times
- ◆ When walking pets owners are responsible for the proper disposal of waste.
- ◆ Allowing any animal to bark, whine, or howl for a prolonged period of time is prohibited and a ticket could be issued.
- ◆ If your pet bites a person or another pet in an unprovoked attack, the pet is subject to quarantine, could be deemed vicious, requiring the pet license be revoked and the animal to be removed from city limits.
- ◆ For Lost or Found Animals contact City Hall or the Police Department after hours.

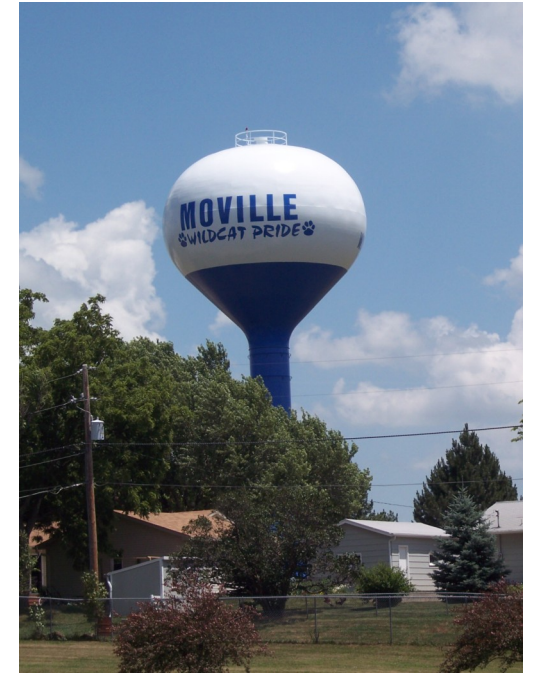

# Property Maintenance

## Lawn Care & Trees

- ◆ To ensure quality air, the burning of garbage, leaves, and yard waste is prohibited. Except for (2) weeks in the spring and (2) weeks in the fall. Notice will be published in the newspaper.
- ◆ Mowing grass into the street is prohibited, grass gets into the storm sewer and causes expensive sewer backups and malfunction.
- ◆ Compost dump site is available for the disposal of trees, branches and grass clippings only. Site is under camera surveillance, violators will be ticketed.
- ◆ Yards that contain noxious weeds or provide habitat for snakes, rodents or vermin must be mowed or sprayed.
- ◆ All Trees and shrubs should be properly trimmed for pedestrians using sidewalks.
- ◆ The City is responsible for removing damaged or hazardous trees or shrubs within the City right-of-way. This may include items that obstruct the view of traffic.
- ◆ Trees located on private property are the responsibility of the property owner.
- ◆ To request a list of trees that are allowed within the city, contact City Hall.
- ◆ Contact Iowa One Call 48 hours before digging to have the utilities located.

## Sidewalks

- ◆ To keep pedestrians and bicyclists safe, snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours of the cessation of the accumulation.
- ◆ Property owners are responsible for the sidewalks and area from the curb to the property line. Sidewalks that become dangerous are the responsibility of the property owner.
- ◆ To Report a sidewalk that is damaged or has not had the snow removed, call City Hall. 873-3545.

## General Care

- ◆ Vehicles classified as junk vehicles may not be stored within the city limits for more than 48 hours unless the vehicle is stored in a garage.
- ◆ The outdoor storage or placement of household appliances or furnishings, unless designed for the outdoors is prohibited and considered a public nuisance.
- ◆ To ensure birds and animals are kept out of garbage, all garbage set outdoors should be kept in a watertight and tightly closed hard receptacle.

## Snow Parking Emergency

- ◆ It shall be conclusively presumed that any snowfall of two inches or more as officially measured in Sioux City, creates a snow emergency.
- ◆ Whenever an unauthorized vehicle is found on a public street or during a snow emergency the police officer will issue a \$30 parking ticket and has authority to have the vehicle towed at the owners expense.
- ◆ On street parking may resume when the street or alley has been cleared of the snow.

# Utilities

## Water & Wastewater Service

- ◆ The City of Merville mails bills the 1st of the month and balance is due the 20th. Shut-offs for non-payment will occur on or about the 11th of each month. Automatic monthly payments are available.
- ◆ Outdoor Watering. If you would like to reduce the cost of watering the garden or yard, a second meter may be purchased and installed at the homeowners expense. Installing this meter eliminates wastewater charges for outdoor watering.

## Garbage Pickup

- ◆ Garbage is collected every Thursday morning. To ensure that garbage is collected efficiently, place can at curbside Wednesday evening, with can opening towards the street. Cans should be placed at least ten (10) feet away from vehicles and trees to help ensure pickup can be accomplished.

## Recycling Pickup

- ◆ Curbside pickup every other Wednesday, green recycling tubs are free at City Hall. You may purchase a large pink container, from the Woodbury County Landfill by calling 873-3837
- ◆ Woodbury County Landfill located 7 miles south on Merville Blacktop and 3 miles east on 220th St. Accepting garbage, appliances, paint, and construction materials.
