A FEW REMINDER TO KEEP IN MIND AS SPRING ARRIVES

<u>Open Burning of Yard Waste</u> is scheduled for April 23 - May 8. ONLY during this designated time period are you allowed to burn yard waste. The City provides a yard waste dump site to residents of Moville and is located southwest of the CPS facility; you may dispose of yard waste, branches and leaves, extra dirt and broken concrete at this location. Please take care to place the materials in the correct piles and do not leave plastic bags or garbage at the site.

<u>Mowing</u> Do not mow grass clippings into the streets. The grass clippings clog the storm sewers and can causes sewer backups. It is expensive for the city and home owner.

<u>Weed/Mowing Complaints</u> If City Hall receives a mowing or weed complaint, a letter is mailed to the resident notifying them to mow within 10 days. If not mowed before the 11th day, the city will mow the yard. The fee for mowing and cutting weeds shall be the sum of sixty dollars (\$60) per hour.

<u>Operating Golf Carts</u> City Council approved an ordinance, allowing for the operation of golf carts on city streets by persons possessing a valid driver's license. However, a golf cart shall not be operated upon a city street which is a primary road extension (Hwy 140) through the city but shall be allowed to cross a city street which is a primary road extension through the city. The golf carts shall be equipped with a slow moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag and operate on the streets only from sunrise to sunset. Golf carts operated on city streets shall be equipped with adequate brakes and shall meet these safety requirements.

HELP KEEP MOVILLE CLUTTER FREE

Moville City Council will continue with its annual spring inspections around Moville. If the Council determines that a property is considered a public nuisance we will take photographs, make a report and send a letter to property owners and renters whose property is considered a nuisance. We encourage you to take a look around your business, home, shed or garage and help us clean up Moville.

Here are a few tips to help avoid getting a nuisance letter:

- 1. Dispose of tree limbs, branches & grass clippings at the City's free dump site;
- 2. Spray weeds, keep lawns mowed and grass trimmed;
- 3. Remove piles of clutter from around the outside of your garage, home or business;
- 4. Dispose of old wood, metal, concrete, tires, pallets, fencing, propane tanks;

If you receive a nuisance letter, you will be given time to remedy the problem before a second inspection occurs. If upon second inspection the problem has not been satisfactorily resolved, the city has the right to clean up the area and charge the property owner for the cleanup work.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE CITY CLEANUP

April 8-Logan Addition April 22– North of Main April 29 -South side of Main The City will <u>NOT</u> pick up normal household garbage, recycling items, yard waste, liquid filled containers, or construction materials. City crews will pick up curbside junk starting at 7:00 a.m. on Monday mornings and it may take a few days to get all the junk picked up, so please be patient and we appreciate your cooperation with the clean up. **ITEMS REQUIRING \$5 TAG: tires, washer, dryer, fridge, stove, dehumidifier, a/c units, dishwasher, water heater, freezer, microwave. \$8 TAGS: Computer monitors and Televisions.** Tags are available at City Hall during business hours. Residents are responsible for taping the tag to the item or it won't be picked up.

UPDATE ON IMPROVEMENTS AROUND MOVILLE



<u>**THE RIDGE:</u>** The City of Moville and Western Iowa Telephone are in the initial stages of an exciting new community housing development project. The new development, called *The Ridge*, will be located on the north side of Moville on property owned by Western Iowa Telephone.</u>

Although interest in the project is already strong, at this point, details regarding the number of lots available, the size of the lots or the cost of the lots have not yet been determined. The project will likely be completed in phases. Although the information available at this time is limited, a web site has been built to provide details as they develop. Anyone that's interested in possibly purchasing a lot in the development can also leave their email address on the web site to be contacted as soon as specific sale information is available. The web site is theridgemoville.com.

Sites will likely be available for sale sometime in April or May with construction to be possible this fall. Stay tuned for more information on this exciting project!

<u>THE MAIN STREET PAVILION PROJECT</u> has been in the fundraising phase for almost two years, and now the dream has become a reality. Materials were delivered in late March and the construction will take place in mid– April. Once the utilities are in place and the weather is cooperating, the Committee will be looking for volunteers to assist with the concrete installation. The Committee is awaiting confirmation on the receipt of a Vision Iowa CAT grant to allow for the resurfacing of the tennis courts in conjunction with the Pavilion Project. The City hopes to have the Pavilion operational for the annual Moville Days Celebration.

MOVILLE'S FUTURE VISION March 21, 2012, MCDAI, City of Moville and Woodbury Central Board held a joint Community planning meeting at WC to discuss Moville's vision of the future. Many great ideas were shared and discussed. Through this planning event the City of Moville will have some ideas on what direction the community wants to go in the future. Stay tuned for future updates.

<u>MCDAI</u> has been working together to compile project ideas and prepare for the installation of a water line to the Grocery Store. The Community was very supportive at the recent St. Patrick's Supper and Trivia Night. MCDAI will continue to work with the City, school and local leaders to help facilitate making improvements to Moville's business community.
