SPORT COURT UPDATE

The Moville Community Development Association, Inc., (MCDAI) is expecting the sport court update to be completed this summer on the basketball/tennis court area on Main Street. The update will include three enclosed sides for a regulation size basketball court, three enclosed sides for a tennis court, pickle ball and an area for four square. The enclosures will be provided by black sport court fence that is specifically designed to be more forgiving than an aluminum fence.

There have been many fundraising efforts to support the sport court; the most recent was Trivia Night which was hosted by MCDAI at the Community Center on February 18th, 2017. This year the event raised \$3,000 and topped off the amount necessary for the project!

While the sport court project is fully funded the option to "Give a Hoop" is still available. If you would like to donate \$2,500 you can have naming rights for one the hoops. There will be four new goal setter hoops installed during the update, there are only two left so be sure to contact someone from MCDAI if you are interested. Any amount that is now donated will go toward other MCDAI project in Moville.

Thank you to all of the individuals that helped bring the goal of a sport court in our city come to fruition!

The City will NOT pick up the following items: Normal household garbage, recycling items, yard waste, liquidfilled containers, construction materials.

The following items must have a tag on them to be picked up (tags can be purchased at City Hall):

Tires: \$6 or \$7 with a rim

Appliances: \$7 (washer, dryer, fridge, stove, dehumidifier, a/c

units, dishwasher, water heater, freezer, microwave)

TV's: 19" and under \$15,

19" and over \$20, projector screen \$25

All Materials Need To Be Curbside By 6:00am

CITY REQUIRED PERMITS

Moville City Council has a building inspector to handle most permits. Permits are available on the city's website under City Hall or you can stop at City Hall and pick one up. Once the permit has been completed the form can be dropped off at City Hall and the inspector will be notified.



Permits are required for various construction projects: **BUILDING**, **REMODELING**, **FENCE**, **SIDEWALK**, **and OPEN GRADING PER-MITS**. Please call City Hall with questions.

2017 PET REGISTRATION REMINDER

Register your pet for 2017 by picking up the form at City Hall or download it at www.visitmoville.com. The annual cost to register your pet is \$5 if they are neutered and \$10 for non-neutered pets.

Please return form, fee and a copy of current vaccination record to City Hall. Feel free to use the overnight drop box and staff will mail the 2017 tags registration. Pets not licensed by May 31st will be assessed a \$3.00 per month late fee and may be subject to violation of City Ordinances and Fines.

A FEW REMINDS AS SPRING ARRIVES

<u>Open Burning of Yard Waste</u> is scheduled for April 1st through April 14th. ONLY during this designated time period are you allowed to burn yard waste. The City provides a yard waste dump site (for Moville residents) located southwest of the CPS facility; you may dispose of yard waste, branches and leaves at this location. Please take care to place the materials in the correct piles and do not leave plastic bags or garbage at the site.

- **Mowing** Do not mow grass clippings into the streets. The grass clippings clog the storm sewers and can causes sewer backups. It is expensive for the city and home owner.
- **Weed/Mowing Complaints** If City Hall receives a mowing or weed complaint, a letter is mailed to the resident notifying them to mow within 10 days. If not mowed before the 11th day, the city will mow the yard. The fee for mowing and cutting weeds shall be the sum of sixty dollars (\$60) per hour.
- Operating Golf Carts Golf carts are allowed on city streets by persons possessing a valid driver's license. However, a golf cart shall not be operated upon a city street which is a primary road extension (Hwy 140) through the city but shall be allowed to cross a city street which is a primary road extension through the city. The golf carts shall be equipped with a slow moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag and operate on the streets only from sunrise to sunset. Golf carts operated on city streets shall be equipped with adequate brakes and shall meet these safety requirements.
- **Operating UTV's** Same rules apply as operating a golf cart.
- **Operating ATV's** Currently ATV's are not permitted on City streets.
