Fair Street Sidewalk

The City of Moville has been named the recipient of two grants that will allow the City to add a sidewalk along Fair Street that will be completely grant funded! In 2017 Missouri River Historic Development (MHRD) awarded the City \$80,000 and in March 2018 the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) voted to grant the City \$195,000 to complete funding for this project.

There has been feedback that this area has proven to be very treacherous for pedestrians. As an area that many students utilize on their way to and from Woodbury Central School, the project had the support of the school administration as well as the Safe Routes to School group.

The City is excited to start this construction for this project in the Spring of **2019**. There are a lot of great changes and updates taking place in Moville and we want to thank all of the dedicated volunteers and groups making things happen!

SPRING CLEANING

Thinking of spring cleaning? Be sure to note the clean-up days for your neighborhood and put out items you no longer use. The City crews will pick up items that have been placed at the curb by 6:00am.

South of Main Street: April 9th North of Main Street: April 16th Logan Addition: April 23rd

The City will NOT pick up the following items: Normal household garbage, recycling items, yard waste, liquid-filled containers, construction materials.

The following items must have a tag on them to be picked up (tags can be purchased at City Hall):

<u>Tires</u>: \$6 or \$7 with a rim <u>Appliances</u>: \$7 (washer, dryer, fridge, stove, dehumidifier, a/c units, dishwasher, water heater, freezer, microwave) <u>TV's</u>: 19" and under \$15, 19" and over \$20, projector screen \$25

All Materials Need To Be Curbside By 6:00am

Remember to register your pet by picking up the form at City Hall or download the form at www.visitmoville.com. The annual cost to register your pet is \$5 if they are neutered and \$10 for non-neutered pets.

BUILDING PERMITS

Moville City Council has a building inspector to handle most permits. Permits are available on the city's website, visitmoville.com under the City Hall tab or you can stop at City Hall and pick up a permit. Once the permit has been completed the form can be dropped off at City Hall and the inspector will be notified. Please remember this process does take around ten days. If you are planning a construction project, be sure to calculate the time it takes the Inspector to do his job.

Permits are required for: **BUILDING, REPURPOS-ING, REMODELING, FENCE, SIDEWALK, and OPEN GRADING PERMITS.** Please call City Hall with any questions you may have with regard to building permits.



SPRING REMINDERS...

Open Burning. This is available for yard waste only and is scheduled for April 7th through April 22nd. ONLY during this designated time period are you allowed to burn yard waste. The City provides a yard waste dump site (for Moville residents) located southwest of the CPS facility; you may dispose of yard waste, branches and leaves at this location. Please take care to place the materials in the correct piles and do not leave plastic bags or garbage at the site. The tree dump is not for building materials/boards, etc.

- •<u>Mowing</u> Do not mow grass clippings into the streets. The grass clippings clog the storm sewers and can causes sewer backups. It is expensive for both the city and home owner.
- •Weed/Mowing Complaints Grass and/or weeds need to be mowed by the 15th of the month from May through October. If grass and/or weeds are not mowed by that time the city will mow the yard. The fee for mowing and cutting weeds shall be the sum of fifty dollars (\$50) per hour and will be assessed to the homeowner. See the newspaper for monthly notice.
- •**Operating Golf Carts** Golf carts are allowed on city streets by persons possessing a valid driver's license. However, a golf cart shall not be operated upon a city street which is a primary road extension (Hwy 140) through the city but shall be allowed to cross a city street which is a primary road extension through the city. The golf carts shall be equipped with a slow moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag and operate on the streets only from sunrise to sunset. Golf carts operated on city streets shall be equipped with adequate brakes and shall meet these safety requirements.

•**Operating UTV's** Same rules apply as operating a golf cart.

•**Operating ATV's** Same rules apply as operating a golf cart.

Tornado Sirens will be tested at 7:00 pm on the THIRD MONDAY of each month from March through October.


