CITY ELECTION OUTCOME

In November 2021 City elections were held for the City of Moville. Two City Council positions were open as well as the Mayor post was up for election.

Nate Bauer was not seeking re-election for his seat on the City Council. Bauer had been on the Council for 14 years, his time and talents have been much appreciated while he served the community in that capacity.

Council Member Paul Malm was seeking re-election, a position that he has held for the past four years. Bret Hayworth had requested to be written in on the ballot during the election. Both Malm and Hayworth tallied enough votes to receive spots on the Council.

James Fisher was also re-elected as Mayor, a post he has held for 20 years. Mayor Fisher takes great pride in serving in this capacity and appreciates the opportunity to continue working with Moville residents.

SNOW EMERGENCY

The City of Moville has a snow parking ordinance for winter months. This Ordinance is to help get our streets plowed quickly and avoid personal property damage.

PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCY. Do not park any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street during a Snow Emergency unless the snow has been removed from said area and snow has stopped accumulating. Whenever an unauthorized vehicle is found, a municipal officer can have the vehicle towed.

A snow emergency parking ban will continue through the duration of the snow or ice storm and the seventy-two (72) hour period after cessation of the storm.

DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS. Parking is permitted during a snow emergency in two designated parking areas: Haskell Pool parking lot and on the west side of the 200 block of North Fourth Street (soccer fields parking lot) for periods of up to seventy-two (72) hours of continuous use.

MUNICIPAL INFRACTION. Parking a vehicle in violation of this ordinance four or more times between November 1 and May 1 or leaving a vehicle in a designated parking area for over seventy-two (72) hours shall constitute a Municipal Infraction. A civil penalty of \$100 shall be imposed for each violation. Each day a violation continues shall constitute an additional infraction.



PET REGISTRATION

Pet Registration for 2022 is now open! Register your pet by picking up the form at City Hall or download the form at www.visitmoville.com. The annual cost to register your pet is \$5 if they are neutered/spayed and \$10 for non-neutered/spayed pets.

Please return form, fee and a copy of current vaccination record to City Hall. Feel free to use the overnight drop box and staff will mail 2022 tags. Pets not licensed by March 31st will be assessed a \$3.00 per month late fee and will be subject to violation of City Ordinances and Fines.

The Moville Police Department will be partnering with the State of Iowa for the Special Traffic Enforcement Program or STEP. The STEP program invites statewide participation by all law enforcement in Iowa in cooperative "high visibility" traffic enforcement effort coordinated around a holiday.

These events call for heightened traffic enforcement for all traffic violations with the main effort to raise awareness in safety belt use as the best means of protection in the case of a motor vehicle collision.
