## CITY UPDATES

Many projects were wrapped up in the fall; the first part of Frontage Road was widened and opened, blacktop overlay was added to South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and a portion of Jackson Street with the addition of ADA sidewalks. Along Frontage Road Security National Bank is constructing a brand new 2 million dollar building that is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2023. The current bank building has been purchased with the intent to donate it to the Moville Historical Society for its permanent home.

Further down Frontage Road the Moville Medical Clinic will see a dramatic transformation, it will go from a blank lot to a 3.6 million dollar building that will house a medical clinic, specialty care physicians, and therapies. The Medical Clinic group has been working tirelessly to see this dream come to fruition, the commitment from Woodbury County REC for a low interest loan has helped to secure the future of this project.

During the winter months the Public Works department will be working on a few projects when they aren't pushing snow. One project they will be working on will be updating the restrooms at the Fire Station. The main area and the kitchen of the Fire Station has received a big facelift last winter, this winter the guys will finish the update by painting the bathroom and adding new dividers.

Another project will include refreshing the main area at the Community Center. The update will include patching/painting walls, fixing broken floor tiles and fixing broken doors. The Community Center plays host to

**SNOW EMERGENCY**

The City of Movable has a snow parking ordinance for winter months. This Ordinance is to help get our streets plowed quickly and avoid personal property damage. To receive text alerts about a snow emergency please sign up for Alert Iowa, information can be found on the next page.

**PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCY.** Do not park any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street during a Snow Emergency unless the snow has been removed from said area and snow has stopped accumulating. Whenever an unauthorized vehicle is found, a municipal officer can have the vehicle towed.

A snow emergency parking ban will continue through the duration of the snow or ice storm and the seventy-two (72) hour period after cessation of the storm.

**DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS.** Parking is permitted during a snow emergency in two designated parking areas: Haskell Pool parking lot and on the west side of the 200 block of North Fourth Street (soccer fields parking lot) for periods of up to seventy-two (72) hours of continuous use.

**MUNICIPAL INFRACTION.** Parking a vehicle in violation of this ordinance four or more times between November 1 and May 1 or leaving a vehicle in a designated parking area for over seventy-two (72) hours shall constitute a Municipal Infraction. A civil penalty of \$100 shall be imposed for each violation. Each day a violation continues shall constitute an addi-

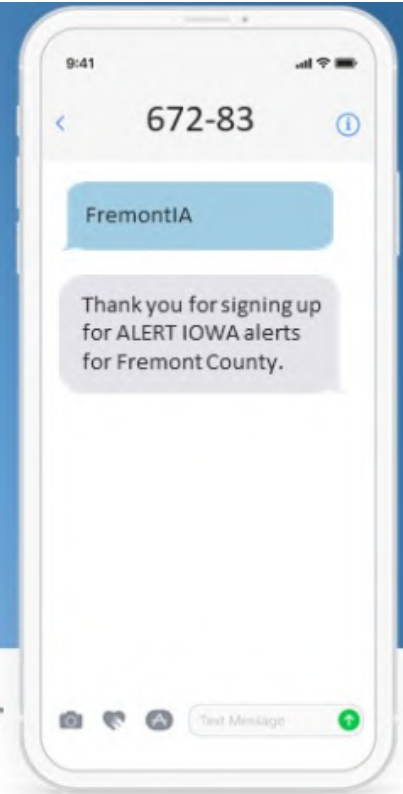

Please return form, fee and a copy of current vaccination record to City Hall. Feel free to use the overnight drop box and staff will mail 2023 tags. Pets not licensed by March 31st will be assessed a \$3.00 per month late fee and will be subject to violation of City Ordinances and Fines.

# MOVILLE POLICE PARTICIPATE IN STEP GRANT

Iowa's sTEP invites statewide participation by all law enforcement in Iowa in cooperative "high visibility" traffic enforcement effort coordinated around a holiday.
