

Moville City Council Budget Meeting
January 24, 2018

Mayor Fisher called the meeting to order at around 6:00 p.m. Roll Call: Mike Ofert, Paul Malm, Tom Conolly, Nate Bauer, and Bruce Schmidt, all present.

Guests present include Police Chief Jereme Muller, Jerry Sailer, Stee Maxwell, and Kent Baker.

Malm motioned to approve the meeting's agenda, seconded by Ofert. Ayes, motion carries.

Stee Maxwell gave a MCDAI update on Chet's Moville Market, the prospect of a hotel feasibility study, the proposed development at 102 S. 4th Street and donations to update the City's Christmas light display.
