Moville City Council Meeting Wednesday October 18, 2023

Mayor Fisher calls the meeting to order at around 6:30 pm. Roll Call: John Parks, Tom Conolly and Bret Hayworth are present. Paul Malm attends via zoom. Joel Robinson is absent. Parks motions to approve agenda, seconded by Malm. Ayes, motion carries. Hayworth motions to approve minutes from the October 4th meeting. Malm seconds. Ayes, motions carries. Hayworth motioned to approve the claims for the month, seconded by Parks. Ayes, motion carries. Park motions to approve the September Treasurer's report, seconded by Hayworth. Ayes, motion carries. No permits to review. Guests present include Pat Smith, Dave Christiansen, Amanda Goodenow. No speakers during Open Forum.

Pat Smith gave a Public Works update. Smith let Council know how much water was pumped last month (7.8 million), replaced a fire hydrant on Jackson Street, pumped 2.8 million gallons of waste water, and ordered/replaced street signs around town. Rehab Systems was in town to clean several blocks of sewer lines and multiple lift stations in Moville. They did quite a bit of mowing and are starting to winterize parks starting with Memorial Park. The Main Street Pavilion will be open until the Halloween Parade then it will be winterized and closed for the season.

Amanda Goodenow from ISG provided an overview of bids that were turned in for the test wells. ISG reached out to six reputable companies requesting a bid and received two; Thein Well Co, Inc. and Sargent Drilling. Goodenow recommended that the City use Sargent Drilling. Hayworth motioned to approve to reward the test well project to Sargent Drilling. Parks seconds. Ayes, motion carries.

Council comments and concerns were discussed.

With no further business Hayworth motions to adjourn around 7:06pm and Parks seconded. All ayes, motion carries-meeting closed.
