Ayes motion carries. Robinson motions to approve the adoption of Ordinance 2022-3-A, seconded by Parks, Ayes motion carries.

Council considers Resolution 2023-27, to set times for Open Burning to November 11th through November 19th, 2023. Conolly motions to approve this Resolution, seconded by Hayworth. Ayes motion carries. This will be allowed barring any County-wide burn bans or weather unsuited for burning.

Robinson motions to approve the Children's Finance Agreement, Seconded by Malm. Ayes motion to approve this agreement.

Robinson motions to approve City employee request for accrued vacation pay and personal time, seconded by Hayworth. Roll call was made. Conolly- aye, Robinson- aye, Hayworth- aye, Malm- aye, Parks- nay, motion carries.

Council comments and concerns were discussed. Robinson and Hayworth discussed concern over resident utilities. Legal advice was given by Thompson. Parks discussed concern of resident. Hayworth reminded council of elections on November 7, 2023 and thanked each council member for their duties and term.

With no further business, Robinson motioned to adjourn at 8:00 pm and Hayworth seconds. All ayes motion carries-meeting closed.
