

Moville City Council – Wednesday, September 17, 2025.

Roll Call: Paul Malm, via zoom, Bret Hayworth, Jared Rapp, Calvin Mellies all present. John Parks is absent. Mellies motions to approve agenda, seconded by Malm. Ayes, motion carries. Mellies motions to approve the minutes, seconded by Rapp. Ayes, motion carries. Hayworth motions to approve the August bills, seconded by Mellies. Ayes, motion carries. Hayworth motions to approve September bills, seconded by Mellies. Ayes, motion carries. Mellies motions to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded by Malm. Ayes, motion carries. Guests present: Pat Smith, Dave Christensen, Chad Thompson, Missi Lenz, Geri Hunter, Tyler Brinkerhoff, Helen St. Peter, Grace Linden, Harold Werley, Shelly Schaeuble, and Emily Reinking.

Open Forum speakers:

Helen St. Peter spoke on behalf of the Garden Club asking for approximately \$900 from City Budget for plants in the 17 planters along Main Street next Spring 2026. The Council will review the budget and respond back.

Tyler Brinkerhoff asked the council for a stop sign installed on 3<sup>rd</sup> and Miller Street, East to West to stop cars from speeding and bottoming out at the dip in the road.

Harold Werley speaks, wondering how much the townspeople enjoy having the Time and Temperature sign on the outside of the Moville Museum.

Grace Linden asks the Council if the city can add the Museum location to signage around town.

The Public Works department will create a handicapped parking spot on Main Street in front of the Museum and install a handrail.

Hayworth motions to approve hiring Zoe Muckey as Pool Manager in Spring of 2026 starting pay at \$16 per hour, seconded by Rapp. Ayes, motion carries.

The council tabled decision on 309 Main Street sidewalk/curb until next meeting.

Rapp motions to pay Bainbridge Construction last bill of \$30,089 will further discuss the retainage and late completion fees, seconded by Mellies. Ayes, motion carries.

Building Inspector Dave Christensen gave an update for the month of August. They issued 24 nuisances, 2 abatements, 2-yard maintenance, 0 letters sent, 0 official notices, 0 citations, 16 no action taken or on hold, 4 pending litigations. Amount billed in August was \$9,301.80.

Bret Hayworth and Paul Malm announced they are seeking re-election for City Council in the November elections.

Mayor Scott Linden announced he is seeking re-election as Mayor in the next City Election as well.

Mayor and Council concerns were discussed. The Council welcomes Moville residents to the council meetings.

Next council meeting is set for Wednesday, October 1st, at 6:30pm.
