

Moville City Council –Wednesday, May 21, 2025.

Roll Call: Paul Malm, via zoom, John Parks, Bret Hayworth, Calvin Mellies all present. Jared Rapp is absent. Parks motions to approve agenda, seconded by Hayworth. Ayes, motion carries. Mellies motions to approve the minutes from the last meeting, seconded by Parks. Ayes, motion carries. Parks motions to approve the bills, seconded by Mellies. Ayes, motion carries. Mellies motions to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded by Hayworth. Hayworth motions to approve all liquor licenses, seconded by Mellies. Ayes, motion carries. Hayworth motions to approve Cigarette/Vape licenses, seconded by Parks. Ayes, motion carries.

Guests present Pat Smith, Dennis Peterson, and Mike Ofert.

Public Works Supervisor Pat Smith updates the council on ISG Engineering details on the Water Improvement Project design to include connecting the existing water system.

Supervisor Smith gives an update of public works department in March/April:

- Pumped 5.9 million gallons of water in April
- Flushed Hydrants
- Met with ISG for water project 90% plan review
- Sampled for E-Coli
- Reviewed operating permit from DNR
- Burned the tree pile
- Set up barricades for car show on 5/7
- Ground curb for Moville Latte and graded entrance off 4th St
- Patched potholes, put down rock in alleys
- Replaced stop sign post on 6th St and installed no parking signs
- Summer help started 5/12
- Received new JD mower
- Planted flowers in pots at pool, Memorial Park and Main St Park
- Filled pool and started balancing, repaired urinal
- Running new wires and boxes for chemical pumps

Dennis Peterson discussed Moville days and possibly setting up a tent. Discussion on where the tent would be located and date it would be set up.

Mike Ofert wanted to discuss the plans on the upkeep of the fields at Myra and who would be responsible for the continued upkeep of the Myra fields. Mayor Linden suggested a list of what Myra and Public Works is responsible for is created to ease any confusion.

The council discussed the foam rental request to take liability and sign a waiver to use at the park during Moville Days. Hayworth Motion to deny, seconded by Mellies. Nays, Motion denied.

Parks motion to approve \$1000 towards Moville Days. Seconded by Hayworth. Ayes, motion carried.

The council discussed the location of the burn pile, no definitive resolution at this time

Mayor and Council concerns were discussed. The Council welcomes Moville residents to the council meetings.
