

Moville Chamber of Commerce Minutes

November 14, 2022

The meeting was called to order by President Chris Countryman and Lisa Fouts gave the opening prayer. Chris thanked Amazon for sponsoring the lunch.

Old Business:

- President Countryman asked for all ballots to be turned in for official counting by Jodi Petersen and Ryan Beardshear.
- Treasurer's Report was given by Jeannie Krueger. A balance of \$8,794.79 was reported.

- School News: Chris Howrey introduced the Student of the Month Shaelee Baker. Informed members that wrestling and basketball have started and the football team will be playing in the UNI dome. WC will be partnering with SB-L for girls' wrestling. The theatre department has finished one week of performances and will be performing Shrek on November 18, 19, & 20.
- Moville News: Second Street project has been finished with 8 new ADA sidewalks. Frontage Road project is nearing completion. Positive items in the news: There was a piece about Moville on KTIV Around Siouxland as well as a story in Sioux City Journal about the number of staff at WC that are family members.
- MCDAI: Stee Maxwell reported that there is a November 15 Board Meeting. There have been many improvement projects completed by MCDAI including the completion of a 3rd duplex on Meredith Lane.

- Election Results: Jodi Petersen announced that Lisa Fouts and Jeremy Rogers were elected to the Chamber Board.
