Old Business:

• MCDAI: Stee Maxwell thanked Deb Vohs for decorating for Trivia Night. They had 26 tables and it was a fun night. MCDAI purchased property on the north end of town to improve the appearance as people enter town from that direction. Lounge chairs and swimming platforms were purchased for Haskell Pool. Infrastructure in 2nd phase of Ridge housing development has been completed. 2 houses have been constructed at this time.
